

IMPACT FEES EFFECTIVE FEBRUARY 7, 2021.**

Pursuant to Section 163.31801(3)(d), Florida Statutes, notice is hereby provided that the Orange County Board of County Commissioners adopted Ordinance No. 2020-31 on October 27, 2020, increasing certain transportation impact fees in Orange County, Florida, effective February 7, 2021, with annual indexing of three point four percent (3.4%) beginning on January 1, 2023.
