SUBJ: Approval to Decrease the Speed Limit on Junction Road

Concerned citizens have requested Orange County to review the posted speed along Junction Road between North Orange Blossom Trail and West Ponkan Road. They have expressed that the posted speed is too high and presents a safety risk.

Pedestrian safety, corridor speed continuity, and recent accident statistics were the primary considerations for a speed reduction analysis along the Junction Road corridor. The Florida Department of Transportation uses a Context Sensitive road classification when determining Target Speed. Target Speed is the highest speed at which vehicles should operate on a thoroughfare in a specific context, consistent with the level of multimodal activity generated by adjacent land uses, providing both mobility and a supportive environment for vehicles, pedestrians, bicycles, and public transit users. This corridor is classified as a C3R-Suburban Residential with a target speed range between 35 mph and 55 mph.

Based on the evaluation performed, USLIMITS2 analysis, roadway characteristics, and operating characteristics, Orange County Traffic Engineering recommends lowering the posted speed limit on Junction Road between North Orange Blossom Trail and West Ponkan Road from 40 mph to 35 mph.

Action Requested: Approval to decrease the speed limit on Junction Road between

North Orange Blossom Trail and West Ponkan Road from 40

mph to 35 mph. District 2.


