RECOMMENDATION:

Selection of one firm and an alternate to provide Third Party Administrator Services, Request for Proposals Y24-1004-KK, from the following firms listed alphabetically:

Heritage Health Solutions, Inc.

Zenith American Solutions, Inc.

Further request Board authorization for the Procurement Division to negotiate and execute a contract in the estimated amount of \$20,622,500 for a one-year term. The firm's fee is \$622,500 is the firm's fee for adjudicating claims and \$20,000,000 is pass through payments to medical providers. Further request authorization for the Procurement Division to renew the contract for four additional one-year terms.

Further request Board authorization for the Procurement Division to formally terminate negotiations with the top ranked firm if we are unable to come to a favorable negotiated agreement and commence negotiations with the next ranked alternate until a successful negotiation is reached.

PROCUREMENT:

The Contractor will review, adjudicate, and process medical claims for services related to Corrections Health, the Medical Clinic, and Ryan White program.

FUNDING:

Funding is available through account numbers 0001-060-3806-3195, 0001-060-2502-3195, and 7014-060-7302-3195. Federal funding is available through the Health Resources and Services Administration.

DISCUSSION:

Proposals were evaluated by the Procurement Committee on April 24, 2024. Commissioner Mayra Uribe was assigned to the Procurement Committee.

Three proposals were received in response to this Request for Proposals. The proposal received from Self Insured Plans DBA 901 Degree Benefits scored too low for Board consideration.

The Health Services Department provides a variety of services, including medical and mental health care, to inmates housed at the Orange County Corrections Department, medical services for the County's indigent healthcare program (Medical Clinic – PCAN), and coordination of medical care to persons living with HIV/AIDS enrolled in the Ryan White Part A Program. As a result, thousands of medical claims are processed every year to pay for services delivered by contracted providers. The Third Party Administrator will be responsible for the adjudication and processing of payments in an accurate and efficient matter. Funds for the payment of claims will be kept in a separate bank account which shall be reconciliated and a report provided for each program on a weekly basis.
