Type of Hearing: To amend Westridge Park Area Municipal Service Benefit Unit (MSBU) for streetlighting to include Westridge Park Phase 2.

Hearing Required by F. S.# Florida Statute Sections 125.01 (01) (q) and 197.3632. This public hearing may be scheduled any time prior to May 31, 2023. **The resolution must be approved by May 31, 2023 to be included on the November 2023 real estate tax bill.**

Notify Abutters: Special Assessments will mail public hearing notices to all of the affected property owners.
