SUBJ: **Second Amendment to Traffic Signal Maintenance and Compensation Agreement Between Orange County and the State of Florida Department of Transportation**

Submitted for approval and execution is the Second Amendment to Traffic Signal Maintenance and Compensation Agreement between Orange County and the State of Florida Department of Transportation. This Agreement has been amended to include Exhibit "E." This amendment better defines the maintenance roles and responsibilities of traffic control devices between both agencies for maintenance of traffic signals at intersections with state-owned facilities. The breakdown of maintenance responsibilities for each agency is shown in Exhibit "E." All terms and conditions of the original Amendment will remain in effect.

The Public Works Traffic Engineering Division and the County Attorney's Office have completed the review of the Second Amendment to Traffic Signal Maintenance and Compensation Agreement and find it acceptable.

Second Amendment to Traffic Signal Maintenance and Compensation Agreement

THIS SECOND AMENDMENT TO TRAFFIC SIGNAL MAINTENANCE AND COMPENSATION AGREEMENT ("2nd Amendment") is made and entered into on this ____ day of _____, 2022, by and between the STATE OF FLORIDA, DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION ("Department"), an agency of the State of Florida, and Orange County, ("Maintaining Agency"), a charter county and political subdivision of the State of Florida, collectively referred to as the "Parties".

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Department and the Maintaining Agency on October 4, 2016, entered into an Amendment to Traffic Signal Maintenance and Compensation Agreement ("Amendment"); and

WHEREAS, the Parties have agreed to amend and modify the Agreement on the terms and conditions set forth herein.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants in this Amendment, the Agreement is amended as follows:

1. **Amendment Description.** The Project is amended to add a new Exhibit "E" to further define specific maintenance responsibilities of the Parties. The additional definition of maintenance responsibility is not intended to modify or amend the compensation to be paid under the Agreement.
2. **Exhibit "E"** attached hereto is hereby added to and incorporated into the Agreement.

Except as hereby modified, amended, or changed, all the terms and conditions of the original Amendment thereto will remain in full force and effect.

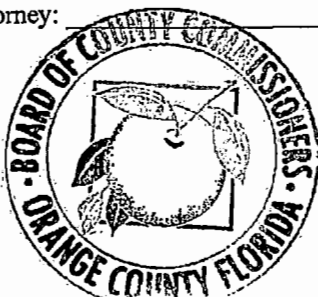
