Orange County Sheriff's Office Request

The Orange County Sheriff's Office is requesting \$11,000 from the FY 2023 Law Enforcement Trust Fund-State Forfeitures for the following purposes:

Contributions:

Florida Crime Prevention Association – \$1,000. This charitable organization was founded in 1969 in an effort to increase awareness of crime prevention strategies and to network with other agencies on how to fight crime victimization. The 54th Anniversary Conference will be held at the Drury Plaza Hotel in Disney Springs, Lake Buena, FL, the week of October 16, 2023.

Harbor House of Central Florida - \$10,000. This contribution will provide comprehensive services to victims of domestic violence and to provide domestic violence education to Central Florida communities. The 2023 Signature Purple Door Luncheon will be held on Thursday, October 5, 2023, at the Rosen Shingle Creek, Orlando, FL.

ACTION REQUESTED: Approval for the Orange County Sheriff's Office to spend \$11,000 from the FY 2023 Law Enforcement Trust Fund-State Forfeitures for eligible contributions to Florida Crime Prevention Association (\$1,000), and Harbor House of Central Florida (\$10,000).
