Orange County Sheriff's Office Request

The Orange County Sheriff's Office is requesting \$16,000 from the FY 2018 Law Enforcement Trust Fund for the following purpose:

**Contributions:**

**Youth Central Connection – \$1,000.** This charitable organization provides resources for at risk youth including job opportunities, mentoring programs, volunteer opportunities, radio and television production, and information about youth related problems and activities in the Central Florida area.

**Central Florida YMCA - \$10,000.** This organization provides students access to education programs and the tools necessary for their academic success.

**FOP Lodge 93 "Cops and Kids" Program - \$5,000.** The "Cops and Kids" program enables under-privileged and at-risk children the opportunity to go shopping with law enforcement officers at Christmas time and pick out gifts for themselves and their family members. These children are selected from referrals submitted by school resource officers, children advocate groups, and local ministries. This program also gives the children the opportunity to interact with law enforcement officers in a positive manner.

**ACTION REQUESTED:** Approval for the Orange County Sheriff's Office to spend \$16,000 from the FY 2018 Law Enforcement Trust Fund to provide eligible contributions to Youth Central Connection (\$1,000), Central Florida YMCA (\$10,000), and FOP Lodge 93 "Cops and Kids" Program (\$5,000).

The Board voted to establish spending limits of 20% for this fund for contributions. At this point in the fiscal year, contributions represent 100% of the total expenditures; however, the restriction applies to total expenditures for the year, at year-end. The Sheriff's Office has stated that they monitor their expenditures, and that they will not exceed the 20% total for contributions.

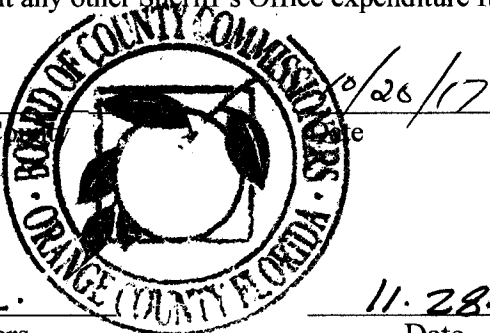

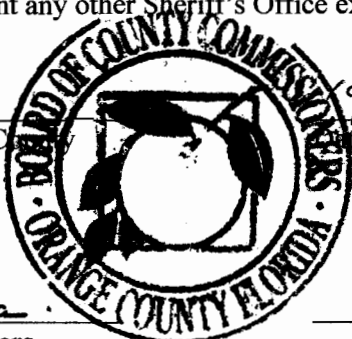
