RECOMMENDATION:

Selection of one firm and two ranked alternates to provide Ryan White Peer Services-Ending HIV Epidemic, Request for Proposals Y21-127-RM, from the following firms listed alphabetically:

- CAN Community Health, Inc.
- Hope and Help Center of Central Florida, Inc.
- The Center for Multicultural Wellness and Prevention, Inc.

Request authority for the Procurement Division to negotiate and execute a one-year contract with a not-to-exceed budget of \$135,000. Further request authorization to renew the contract for four additional one-year terms.

The proposals were evaluated by the Procurement Committee on June 23, 2021. Commissioner Emily Bonilla was assigned to the Procurement Committee.

PURPOSE:

Services will be provided for three Peer Support Specialist positions to perform Psychosocial Support Services (Peer Services) to eligible clients under the Ryan White Part A HIV/AIDS program.

REMARKS:

Three proposals were received in response to the Request for Proposals (RFP) and were evaluated in accordance with the criteria contained in the RFP.

The selected firm will provide Psychosocial Support Services (Peer Services) to eligible clients under the Ryan White Part A HIV/AIDS program. The contract will provide funding for the selected firm to hire three Peer Support Specialist positions in order to assist clients in accessing and maintaining care with the goal of becoming virally suppressed. The Peer Support Specialists will target individuals that are not virally suppressed. The Peer Support Specialists will be trained to implement evidence based strategies in order to engage individuals in care. Services will be focused in Orange County.
