



History

- In County's Long Range
 Transportation Plan as a potential Public/Private
 Partnership project
 - Board approved Palmera West / Lockheed Martin Corporation Agreement (9/18/07)
 - Addressed process to pursue design, rights of way dedication, and construction

 - From the southern ramps to Carrier Drive










Typical Section (FDOT)

- North Section: 9 general travel lanes
- Two dedicated bus lanes
- 12 foot multi-use path
- Bike lanes and sidewalk
- Sand Lake Road interchange reconfiguration



Existing Interchange




Proposed Interchange





- Typical Section (Orange County)
 - South Section: 7-8 general travel lanes
 - Two dedicated bus lanes
 - 12 foot multi-use path
 - Bike lanes and sidewalk





Next Steps

- -Design anticipated to be complete Fall 2019
- -Commence Construction Summer 2020
- -Agreement(s)
 - Rescind Palmera Agreement
 - Rescind Mandarin Drive Extension Agreement
 - New Jurisdictional Agreement between County and FDOT
 - New Construction Funding Agreement between Orange County and Universal (eligible costs, Indemnification, Utilities)
- –MOU and Agreements anticipated to be brought forward in 2019



- FDOT held Public Workshop on November 8, 2018
- FDOT will hold a Public Hearing on December 18, 2018
 - -2100+ Notifications sent
 - Newspaper advertisements
 - -FDOT must hold a public hearing to meet statutory requirements





DEO Grant Agreement

- Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO)
 - -Florida Job Growth Infrastructure Grant Agreement
 - —Provides \$16 Million towards road construction (pending Governor / DEO Approval)
 - -The Extension will enhance mobility
 - Orange County Convention Center
 - Lockheed Martin
 - UCF Rosen School of Hospitality
 - Universal City Development Partners (758 Developable Acres)









DEO Grant Agreement

Agreement Provisions

- Orange County or Assignee to undertake design
- Orange County to receive Rights of Way (Planned Donation)
- Award construction contract through qualified bidding process
- Construction is planned to commence
 June 2020
- Project must be completed within five years of agreement approval
- One-time job creation self reporting (ten years after project completion)
- Estimated 2,534 jobs created
