Report:

The estimated cost for the amending MSBU for maintenance of retention ponds is \$78.00 per lot. The estimated cost for the amending MSBU for streetlighting is \$257.00 per lot, per year. These amending MSBU's would be effective November 1, 2025, and would include Silverleaf Reserve at Hamlin Phase 2C and Silverleaf Oaks at Hamlin Phase 3A subdivisions.
