Equipment:

High Risk Incident Command Equipment – \$106,718.41. The purchase of high risk incident command equipment will include operations core communications headsets, protection gas mask communications cables, and communication ear pieces. These devices are necessary to ensure proper communication, as well as ear protection, during training and high risk missions.
