- Analog signal
- Introduced geolocation
- Wireless calls & texts

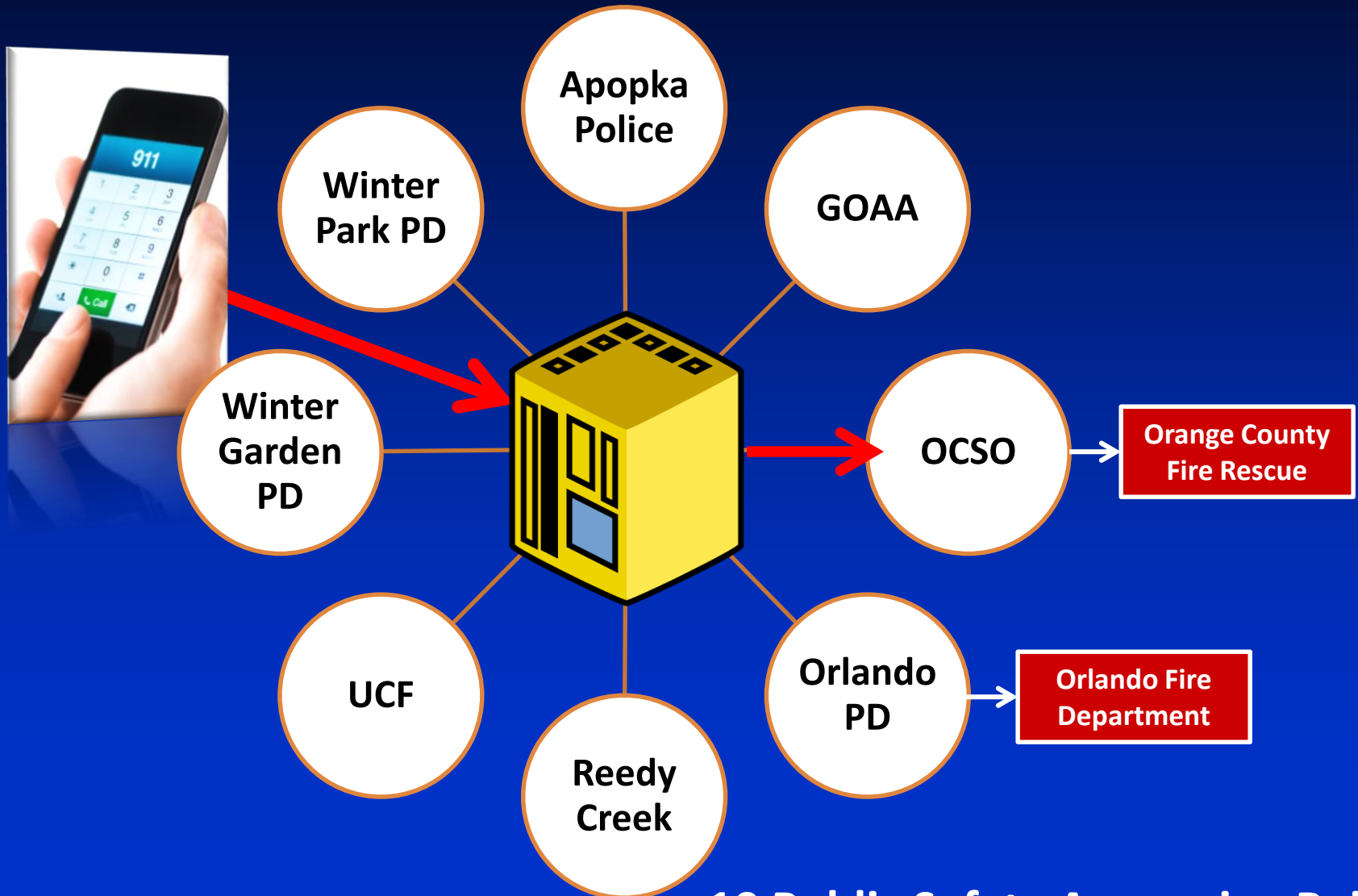
NG 911

- Digital or IP-based 911 system
- Allows voice, photo, video and texts to flow seamlessly from the public to the 911 network

Text to 911 Services

What is It?

The ability to send a short text message to 911 during an emergency

When should Text to 911 be used?

If you are deaf, hard of hearing, or have a speech disability, or if a voice call to 911 is otherwise dangerous or impossible

Where is it available in Central Florida?

Orange County and Osceola County

If a text is sent to 911 in an area without this service a bounce-back text will be received



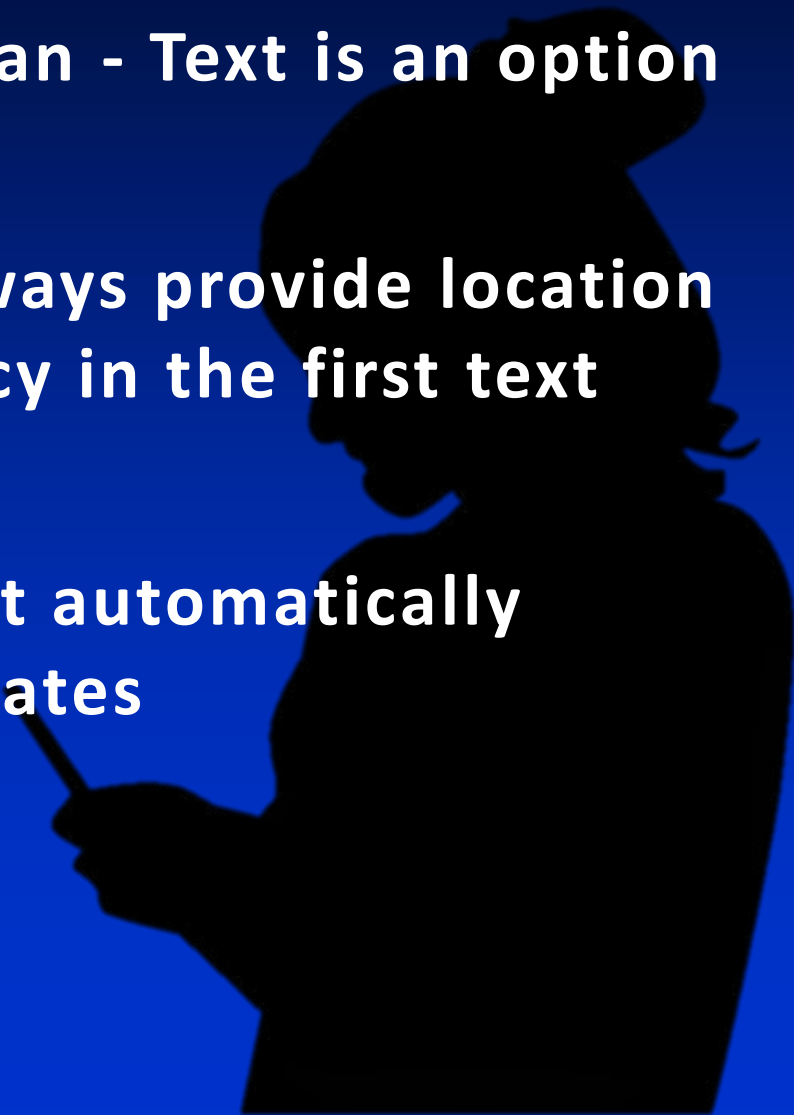

Key Points About Text to 911

- Always call 911 when you can - Text is an option when unable to call
- When using text to 911, always provide location and nature of the emergency in the first text message
- Text to 911 messages do not automatically provide PSAPs with coordinates





Key Points About Text to 911

- **Avoid using abbreviations and slang**
- **Wireless customers must have mobile phones that are capable of sending text messages**
- **Text to 911 is only available in English**
- **Non-English texts may be directed to call 911 so translation services can be provided**
