CONSENT AGENDA ITEM FEBRUARY 6, 2024

At its January 19, 2024 meeting, the Membership and Mission Review Board approved recommending the following advisory board appointments and reappointments:

- A. **Affordable Housing Advisory Board:** Appointment of Dr. Myron L. Rolle to succeed Janae Moore in the advocate for low-income persons representative category with a term expiring June 30, 2025.
- B. **Animal Services Advisory Board:** Reappointment of Rosina A. McVicker in the at large representative category and the appointment of Dr. Nanette P.
