REMARKS

The selection of AECOM Technical Services, Inc. was approved by the Board on September 18, 2018, with an authorization for the Procurement Division to negotiate and execute a final contract within a budget amount of \$8,320,000. At the conclusion of negotiations on November 13, 2018, AECOM Technical Services, Inc., provided a best and final offer of \$9,988,520.
