## RECOMMENDATION:

Selection of one firm and three ranked alternates to provide Engineering Services for Hamlin Water Reclamation Facility Phase 2 Improvements, Request for Proposals Y20-812-TA, from the following firms listed alphabetically. Further, request the Board authorize negotiation and execution of a contract by the Procurement Division provided that the contract does not exceed the budget amount of \$9,000,000.

- Atkins North America, Inc.
- Hazen and Sawyer, P.C.
- Jacobs Engineering Group Inc.
- Tetra Tech, Inc.

The Procurement Committee evaluated the proposals on March 11, 2020. Commissioner Christine Moore was assigned to the Procurement Committee.

## PURPOSE:

This project consists of the design, permitting, and construction administration for the Hamlin Water Reclamation Facility (HWRF) Phase II Construction. The project involves the construction of an expansion to HWRF that will increase the capacity from five million gallons per day (MGD) annual average daily flow (AADF) to 10 MGD AADF. Anticipated improvements include construction of new facilities such as screening, grit removal, aeration basins, secondary clarification, sludge pumping, filtration, disinfection, solids handling, biosolids treatment, odor control, storm water management systems, and other facility improvements required. Sustainability components include energy conservation improvements and continued construction of an advanced wastewater treatment facility with more automation features to effectively collect, store, move, and treat wastewater. The project is located in District 1.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

Four proposals were received in response to the Request for Proposals (RFP). The Procurement Committee evaluated the proposals in accordance with the criteria set forth in the RFP. Consensus scores from the Procurement Committee are attached.
