FY 2021 Law Enforcement Trust Fund-State Forfeitures  
Orange County Sheriff's Office Request

The Orange County Sheriff's Office is requesting \$98,800 from the FY 2021 Law Enforcement Trust Fund-State Forfeitures for the following purpose:

**Orange County Sheriff Office Community Crime Prevention Grant Program – \$98,800.** This is a request to award 15 grants ranging from \$3,800 to \$10,000 to support evidence-based violence reduction, safety and drug abuse education and prevention programs. The Orange County Sheriff's Office vetted 46 applications from a variety of groups. All proposals that met the minimum eligibility criteria were reviewed by an eight-member Sheriff's Office funding approval committee, comprised of both sworn and civilian employees, with final approval by Sheriff Mina.

The recipients and amounts are as follows:

1. \$7,500 to The Keri Anne DeMott Foundation, which focuses on awareness and prevention of drunk, impaired, and distracted driving.
2. \$10,000 to United Foundation of Central Florida, Inc., which runs an after-school enrichment, mentoring, and college preparation program in Pine Hills.
3. \$6,000 to Embrace Families Community Based Care for support for siblings in foster care and support for older youth in foster care.
4. \$10,000 to Fresh Breath International for its Boys2Men Mentoring Program.
5. \$3,800 to Wake Up Mentoring, Inc., for its Real Life Coaching Program.
6. \$5,000 to Florida Songwriter's Association for its "So You Want Your Name in Lights" youth mentoring program.

7. \$4,000 to Hope City Refuge for its fast track program for convicted felons to re-enter society.
8. \$7,000 to Tough Biker Corporation, which helps at-risk youth become skilled in mountain biking and allows them a creative form of recreation.
9. \$10,000 to Butterfly Transformation Outreach, Inc. for its Girls Mentoring Program.
10. \$6,500 to The Mental Health Association of Central Florida, Inc. to purchase iPads to expand its virtual service to those in need of mental health counseling.
11. \$5,000 to Central Florida Writers and Publishers Guild for its Central Florida Young Writer's Project.
12. \$5,000 to Just Write Consulting, Inc. for its Career Development Program.
13. \$5,000 to Informed Families/The Florida Family Partnership for its Lock Your Meds Program.
14. \$5,000 to The Perfect Journal, LLC for its Circle of Hope Mentoring Program.
15. \$9,000 to MAN UP Mentoring, Inc. for its Delinquency Prevention and Intervention Program.

**ACTION REQUESTED: Approval for the Orange County Sheriff's Office to spend \$98,800 from the FY 2021 Law Enforcement Trust Fund-State Forfeitures on selected Community Crime Prevention Grant Program recipients.**

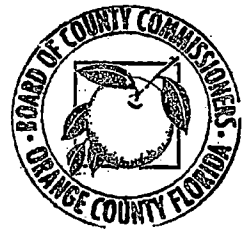
