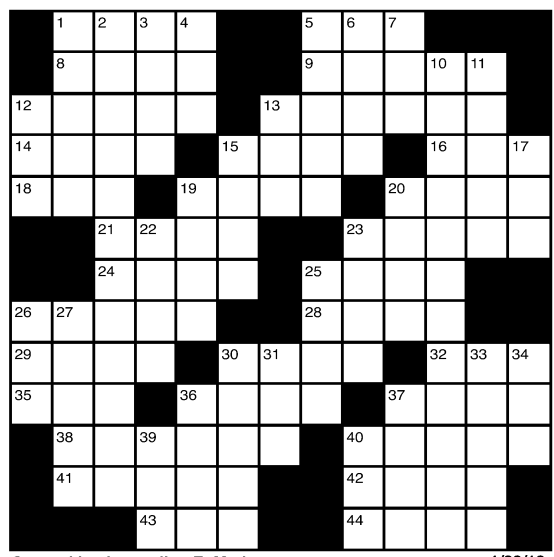

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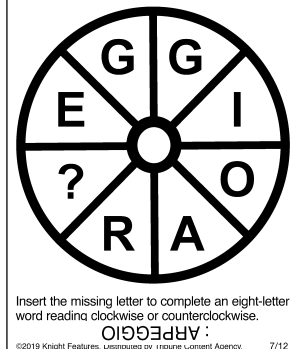

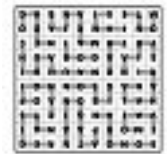

NOTICE OF CHANGE TO THE ORANGE COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN – PUBLIC HEARING

On Tuesday, October 13, 2020, beginning at 2:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, the Orange County Board of County Commissioners ("BCC") will hold a public hearing regarding the transmittal of the proposed 2020-2 Out-of-Cycle Regular Cycle Staff-Initiated Text Amendment to the Orange County Comprehensive Plan ("CP"), as it has been amended, as authorized by Chapter 163, Florida Statutes, for the matter listed below. The BCC will hold this hearing either "in person" at the First Floor of the Orange County Administration Center at 201 S. Rosalind Ave., in downtown Orlando, Florida, OR "virtually," utilizing communications media technology, made permissible pursuant to Governor Ron DeSantis's Emergency Executive Order No. 20-69 related to the Covid-19 state of emergency, as amended, OR a combination of both formats. At the time of publication of this notice, it could not be known by Orange County whether the hearing would be held in person, virtually, or a combination of both formats. In order to determine the format of the hearing, or if you have any questions, please call the Orange County Planning Division at 407-836-5600 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, except legal holidays, or visit the County Calendar at <https://www.ocfl.net/Home/CountyCalendar.aspx>.

The hearing will be hosted by the Orange County Mayor or Vice-Mayor, a quorum will be maintained during the hearing, and the hearing will be conducted and operated by Orange County Government. If the hearing is held virtually, the members of the BCC will participate from different locations via WebEx ©. (See <https://www.webex.com> for more information.)

Regardless of the format, the hearing may be viewed on Orange TV via the internet or television.

Information on Providing Testimony or Participating in the Hearing:

Members of the public who would like to provide testimony and evidence during the hearing may utilize one of the following options:

If the hearing is being held in person, the person may attend the hearing at the First Floor of the Orange County Administration Center at 201 S. Rosalind Ave., in downtown Orlando, Florida.

If the hearing is being held virtually, the person may participate in one of the following two ways:

- The person may participate at a kiosk in Room 105 at the First Floor of the Orange County Administration Center, 201 S. Rosalind Avenue, Orlando, Florida; or
- The person may join and participate from a remote location through the video section of WebEx found in link in the County Calendar at <https://www.ocfl.net/Home/CountyCalendar.aspx>.

Please note, if the hearing is held virtually, the BCC members will not be physically present at the First Floor of the Orange County Administration Center at 201 S. Rosalind Avenue in downtown Orlando, Florida. The person will communicate virtually with the BCC members from a remote location or from the kiosk equipped with a computer laptop located in Room 105 on the First Floor, where the person will see, hear, and speak to the BCC members and the BCC members will see, hear, and will be able to speak to the person.

Please also note, the time allotted to each individual for testimony will be at the sole discretion of the Orange County Mayor or Vice-Mayor, and may be reduced from the normal time limit of three minutes, depending on the number of speakers.

Orange County staff will be present to assist at the kiosk in Room 105 and on the First Floor to ensure that social distancing and other health and safety measures are practiced and enforced.

Also, if you intend to show photographs, presentations, reports, or any other documents when you testify at the hearing, it is requested that you not later than 5:00 p.m. on Monday, October 12, 2020, you either email true and correct copies of such documentary evidence to PublicComment@ocfl.net and note the public hearing to which it relates, or physically deliver copies of such documentary evidence to the Planning Division at the Second Floor of the Orange County Administration Center at 201 S. Rosalind Avenue in downtown Orlando, Florida.

Section 286.0105, Florida Statutes, states that "if a person decides to appeal any decision made by a board, agency or commission with respect to any matter considered at a meeting or hearing, he or she will need a record of the proceedings, and that, for such purpose, he or she may be sure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based."

In accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), if any person with a disability as defined by the ADA needs special accommodation to participate in this proceeding, then not later than two business days prior to the proceeding, he or she should contact the Orange County Communications Division at (407) 836-5651.

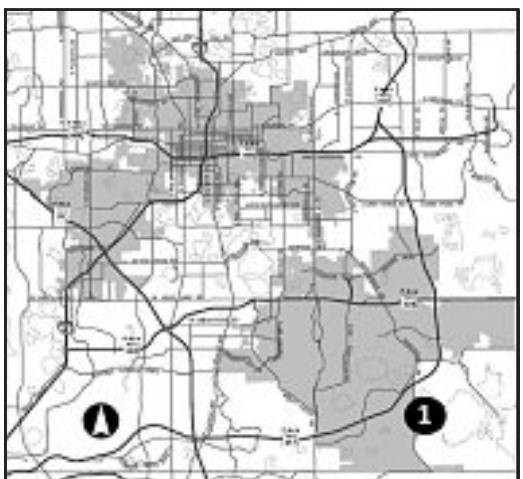
NOTICE OF LAND USE CHANGE

The City of Orlando proposes to amend the Growth Management Plan to change the use of land within the areas shown on the map below. On Tuesday, October 5, 2020 the Orlando City Council will consider proposed ordinance #2020-35, entitled:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORLANDO, FLORIDA, ANNEXING TO THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY CERTAIN LAND GENERALLY LOCATED EAST OF NARCOOSSEE ROAD, SOUTH OF KIRBY SMITH ROAD, AND WEST OF LAKE WHIPPOORWILL, AND COMPRISED OF 17.25 ACRES OF LAND, MORE OR LESS, AMENDING THE CITY'S ADOPTED GROWTH MANAGEMENT PLAN TO DESIGNATE THE PROPERTY AS URBAN VILLAGE, IN PART, AND CONSERVATION, IN PART, ON THE CITY'S OFFICIAL FUTURE LAND USE MAP, AND TO ESTABLISH A SUBAREA POLICY TO PROVIDE DETAILED DEVELOPMENT CRITERIA; PROVIDING FOR CONSENT TO THE MUNICIPAL SERVICES TAXING UNIT FOR LAKE WHIPPOORWILL; PROVIDING FOR AMENDMENT OF THE CITY'S GROWTH MANAGEMENT PLAN; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, CORRECTION OF SCRIVENER'S ERRORS AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

A public hearing on this ordinance will be held during Council's regular meeting beginning at 2:00 p.m. in response to the COVID-19 pandemic and social distancing efforts, members of the public are advised to check the following city website for up-to-date information on any changes to the manner in which the meeting will be held and the location. Interested parties are invited to watch the meeting live and may participate by providing public comment during the meeting or submitting written public comment in advance regarding the proposed ordinance. The opportunity to provide public comment is available until the designated public comment portion of the item is closed. This meeting may be viewed live on Orange TV channel 488, on the city's website at orlando.gov/watchonline or the city's YouTube page. Written public comment must include your name, address, phone number and topic. Comments are limited to a maximum of 700 words per item and may be submitted by one of the following: (1) online at orlando.gov/councilcomment; (2) email to cityclerk@orlando.gov; (3) mail to City Clerk, Public Comment, City of Orlando, 400 S. Orange Ave., Orlando FL 32801; or (4) drop off to the 1st floor security station at City Hall. Written public comment received by 9 a.m. on Monday, October 5 are distributed to Council and attached to the related agenda item for public viewing. Appellants and Parties to Appeals and Quasi-Judicial Hearings must submit their documentary evidence and presentations to orlando.gov/councilcomment by 5 p.m. on Wednesday, September 30. Documentary evidence and presentations received by 5 p.m. September 30 are distributed to Council and attached to the related agenda item for public viewing. Items received after the deadline will not be considered at the meeting. All items received are public record. The proposed ordinance may be inspected online at orlando.gov. Anyone who desires to appeal an official decision made at this meeting, if an appeal is permitted by law, may need to obtain a verbatim record of the proceedings that includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is based. The City of Orlando is committed to reasonably accommodating the communication needs of persons with disabilities.
