Resolution Supporting the Green Mountain Scenic Byway

The Green Mountain Scenic Byway Organization was established to protect, enhance, preserve and maintain the intrinsic resources of a designated 45.2 mile corridor. The Green Mountain Scenic Byway begins at the intersection of Old Highway 441 and Lakeshore Drive in Lake County and ends at the intersection of Plant and Dillard Streets in Winter Garden.

The Green Mountain Scenic Byway Organization is seeking to obtain a National Scenic Byway designation through the Federal Highway Administration to bring national recognition to the intrinsic resources of Orange County as another method to ensure the preservation of the County's recreational resources and scenic beauty while bringing increased economic benefit to the community.

This resolution is being provided at the request of the Green Mountain Scenic Byway Organization. It is requested that the Board approve and execute the resolution for the support of the Green Mountain Scenic Byway. This resolution has been reviewed by the County Attorney's Office and found acceptable as to form.
