- Over 6000 new cases in Orange County in past two weeks
 - 14 days' positivity rate is 7.56%
- Barnett Park Health Services testing site
 - 24,162 total tests since opening rapid testing Nov 9, 2020
 - 959,125 masks distributed
 - 100,165 bottles of hand sanitizer distributed
- Small business PPE distribution
 - Dec 1-3, 2020
 - Anticipate distribution of 2 million masks


