Adoption of Future Land Use Map Amendment SS-22-10-084, Ordinance, and Concurrent Rezoning Request RZ-22-10-085, Jason Searl, Gray Robinson, P.A.

c. Rezoning RZ-22-10-085

**Consideration:** To change the zoning designation from A-2 (Farmland Rural District) and R-T-2 (Combination Mobile Home and Single-Family Dwelling District) to I-1/I-5 Restricted (Industrial District - Light) for a commercial landscape nursery with retail sales.

**Location:** District 3; property generally located on the west side of Narcoossee Road, south of Brentwood Drive, and north of Gentian Street.; Orange County, Florida (legal property description on file in Planning Division)

New Restriction:

<u>5. Cumulative square footage of all buildings shall not exceed 8,000 square feet, not including shade structures.</u>

A motion was made by Commissioner Uribe, seconded by Commissioner Gomez Cordero, to make a finding of consistency with the Comprehensive Plan; further, adopt Amendment SS-22-10-084, Industrial (IND) Future Land Use; further, adopt the Small-Scale Ordinance 2023-15; further, approve the rezoning request from A-2 (Farmland Rural District) and R-T-2 (Combination Mobile Home and Single-Family Dwelling District) to I-1/I-5 Restricted (Industrial District Light) zoning for a commercial landscape nursery with retail sales subject to the four (4) Restrictions listed under the Planning and Zoning recommendation in the Staff Report dated March 22, 2023; and further, approve new restriction #5. The motion carried by the following vote:
