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SUBJ: **Construction of Speed Humps on Overlake Avenue and March Avenue**

The Pershing K-8 School located on Pershing Avenue is scheduled to open in August 2019. The renovated and expanded school was designed to accommodate additional students; therefore, it is anticipated that this school will generate additional traffic and pedestrians coming to and from the school. Due to student safety concerns expressed by residents, Orange County Public Schools committed to construct traffic calming devices on both Overlake Avenue and March Avenue with County approval.

The Orange County Public Schools' construction plans include a reference to speed humps on Overlake Avenue and March Avenue. The project is being funded by Orange County Public Schools.

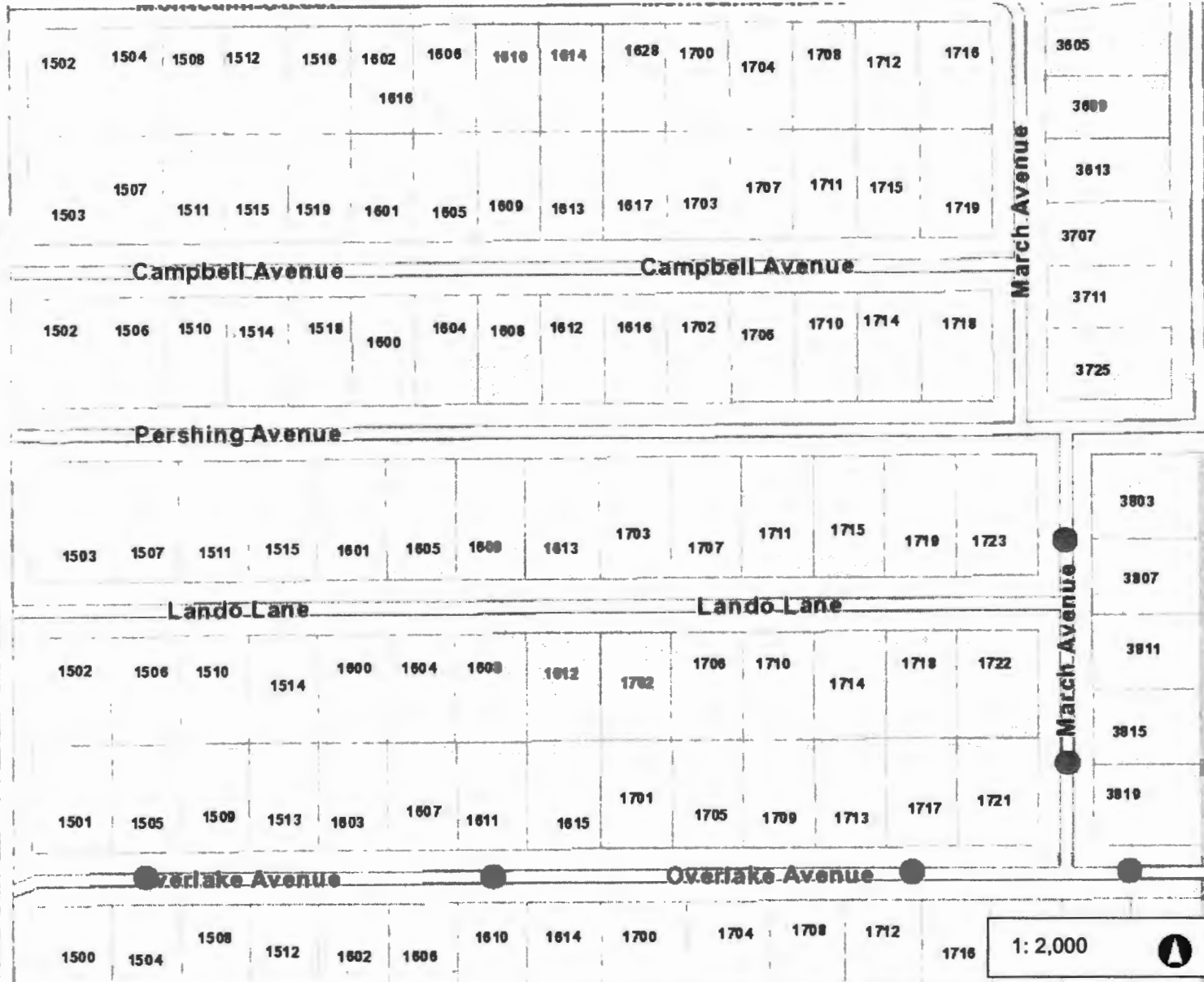
Staff recommends that the Board approve the construction of speed humps on Overlake Avenue and March Avenue.
