ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval to award Invitation for Bids Y19-701-CH, Sadler Road & U.S. 441 Intersection Improvements – FPN: 441400-1-58-01 FAN: D518-087-B, to the low responsive and responsible bidder, Atlantic Civil Constructors Corporation, in the estimated contract award amount of \$362,068.35.

PROCUREMENT:

The Sadler Road and U.S. 441 intersection improvements project consists of adding a right turn lane on Sadler Road at the intersection. The work includes roadway widening, milling and resurfacing, drainage improvements, signing and pavement marking, and signal loops replacement. The total length of the project is approximately 880 linear feet or 0.166 mile. The project is located in District 2.

FUNDING:

This project will be funded by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) exclusive of the bid amount for Indemnification of \$100, which is a Federal Aid ineligible item. Therefore, the County would provide funding for indemnification of \$100. This non-reimbursable funding will supplement the reimbursable funding in the amount of \$361,968.35. Funding is available in account number: 7530-072-7373-6311.

APPROVALS:

The Public Works Engineering Division and the Highway Construction Division concur with this recommendation.

REMARKS:

Three bids were received in response to this Invitation for Bids (IFB) and were evaluated for responsiveness, responsibility, and price reasonableness.

Award of Invitation for Bids Y19-701-CH, Sadler Road & U.S. 441 Intersection Improvements – FPN: 441400-1-58-01 FAN: D518-087-B

The bid submitted by Florida Safety Contractors, Inc. was deemed non-responsible for failure to submit similar projects which met the criteria set forth in the IFB. The solicitation was conducted in accordance with FDOT's competitive procurement for construction services with the Local Agency Program Agreement. The County's M/WBE program is not applicable for this procurement.

Staff evaluated the bids and determined that the low bid is reasonable. References provided were satisfactory for this type of work and Atlantic Civil Constructors Corporation has been determined to be responsible. FDOT concurs with the recommendation of award to Atlantic Civil Constructors Corporation. Therefore, award is recommended to Atlantic Civil Constructors Corporation.
