SUBJECT: Approval of Purchase Order No. M113316, Purchase of Blowers for the Northwest

Water Reclamation Facility

### **ACTION REQUESTED:**

Approval of Purchase Order No. M113316, Purchase of Blowers for the Northwest Water Reclamation Facility, with Atlas Copco Compressors, LLC, in the amount of \$277,700.

### PROCUREMENT:

This purchase order will procure two replacement blowers for the Northwest Water Reclamation Facility (NWRF).

### FUNDING:

Funding is available in account number 4420-038-1357-6410.

## **APPROVALS**:

The Water Reclamation Division concurs with this recommendation.

# **REMARKS**:

The blowers at the NWRF are at the end of their useful life. Six units are scheduled to be replaced through Capital Improvement Projects in the next three years, however, two are failing regularly and require immediate replacement to ensure treatment requirements are met. This was handled as an emergency procurement, as failure to replace the blowers timely may result in negative impacts to both public health and the environment, as well as regulatory enforcement fines.

Price reasonableness was established through comparison to similar purchases from the City of Reading, California, DeFuniak Springs, Florida, Fayetteville Public Works Commission of North Carolina, and Metro Water Services of Nashville, Tennessee. Atlas Copco Compressors, LLC is the manufacturer of the current blowers at the NWRF. Direct replacement of the existing blowers eliminates the need for modification of existing wiring and piping.
