Orange County Sheriff's Office Request

The Orange County Sheriff's Office is requesting \$12,500 from the FY 2024 Law Enforcement Trust Fund-State Forfeitures for the following purposes:

**Contributions:**

**Florida Sheriff's Youth Ranches – \$10,000.** This contribution is in support of juvenile delinquency prevention through early intervention and other family-centered services. The residential campuses, summer camp activities, and outreach programs all include components addressing the dangers of drugs and alcohol, cultural diversity, and conflict resolution.

**Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity, Inc. – \$2,500.** This contribution provides scholarships to deserving youth in our community and supports the Sigma Beta Club mentoring program and other youth development programs. The "Getting in Good Trouble Awards" and Stanley T. Muller Scholarship Luncheon will be held on June 21, 2024, at the Rosen Centre Hotel on International Drive to commemorate the legacy of the Honorable John Robert Lewis.

**ACTION REQUESTED: Approval and execution for the Orange County Sheriff's Office to spend \$12,500 from the FY 2024 Law Enforcement Trust Fund-State Forfeitures for eligible contributions to Florida Sheriff's Youth Ranches (\$10,000) and Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity, Inc. (\$2,500).**


