On July 13, 2021, the Board accepted an award from the State of Florida, Department of Environmental Protection, to the Orange County Environmental Protection Division, for the Septic Upgrade Incentive Program, in the amount of \$154,000 with a grant period from July 29, 2021 through September 30, 2022. On June 18, 2024, the Board approved Modification No. 3 extending the grant period to October 31, 2025, and increasing the total award to the amount of \$2,376,223. This represents an increase in the amount of \$2,222,223.

Funding will be used to provide assistance, through an incentive program, to homeowners within the Wekiwa and Rock Spring Priority Focus Area to ensure septic systems are updated to include nitrogen treatment.

On September 26, 2023, the Board approved an estimated budget for the HIV Emergency Relief Project Grant in the amount of \$10,571,559. The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services awarded to the Health Services Department the grant in the amount of \$11,541,919. In addition, the grant project has generated income from refund to prior year expenditures in the amount of \$3,783 and expects to receive an estimated program income in the amount of \$1,000. This brings the total current grant budget to an amount of \$11,546,702, which represents an increase in the amount of \$975,143. The budget period for this award is from March 1, 2024 through February 28, 2025.

The Ryan White Part A Program provides health and support services for people with the human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) living in Orange, Osceola, Seminole, and Lake counties. Funding is utilized for core and support services consisting of medical and dental care, nutritional supplements, insurance co-pay and premium payments, medical case management, pharmaceutical drug reimbursement, mental health counseling, and substance abuse treatment. Food, transportation, and psychosocial support services complement the program as support components.
