These funds will allow Orange County Environmental Protection Division to upgrade aging air monitoring equipment, provide on-site training opportunities to staff, and support the County's efforts with staying in compliance with National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS). The grant period for this award is from May 1, 2024 through April 30, 2029.
