Orange County Sheriff Behavioral Health Response Pilot Program

The Orange County Sheriff, John W. Mina, will be discussing the Behavioral Health Response Pilot Program created to enhance the response to individuals with a behavioral health crisis. The Orange County Sheriff's Office is collaborating with Devereux Advanced Behavioral Health of Florida to provide two clinicians for one year at a cost of \$115,103.40. These funds will cover the salaries for the clinicians assigned to the pilot program.

Action Requested: Approval for the Orange County Sheriff's Office to spend \$115,103.40 from the FY 2021 Law Enforcement Trust Fund-State Forfeitures to cover salaries for the Devereux Advanced Behavioral Health of Florida clinicians for the Behavioral Health Response Pilot Program.
