## **RECOMMENDATION:**

Selection of one firm and two ranked alternates to provide Professional Transportation Planning and Engineering Services for McCulloch Road Roadway Conceptual Analysis, Request for Proposals Y20-832-CH from the following firms, listed alphabetically. Further, request the Board authorize negotiation and execution of a contract by the Procurement Division provided that the contract does not exceed the budget amount of \$425,000.

- Dewberry Engineers, Inc.
- HDR Engineering, Inc.
- Johnson, Mirmiran & Thompson, Inc.

The Procurement Committee evaluated the proposals on August 12, 2020. Commissioner Betsy VanderLey was assigned to the Procurement Committee.

## **PURPOSE:**

The consultant shall provide professional project planning, preliminary engineering, and environmental analysis services for the road widening study of McCulloch Road. The study limits begin at the intersection of N. Orion Boulevard and McCulloch Road and ends at the intersection of McCulloch Road and N. Tanner Road beyond which McCulloch Road dead ends to the east. The limits of the multipurpose path begins along the south side of McCulloch Road from Alafaya Trail to N. Orion Boulevard. The consultant shall perform those services required for location/design studies, social and environmental effects, multimodal use, safety, engineering reports, and public hearings. The project is located in District 5.
