Phase I: Magnolia Village Construction

ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval to award Invitation for Bids Y21-7050-R2, Lake Gandy Water Quality Improvement Phase I: Magnolia Village Construction, to the low responsive and responsible bidder, Carr & Collier, Inc., in the total contract award amount of \$461,300.

PROCUREMENT:

Work under this contract will consist of constructing two tree box media filters, a wetland biofilter, and an up-flow filter unit to improve water quality of runoff from the Magnolia Village subdivision, which discharges to Lake Gandy. The Project is located in District 2.

FUNDING:

Funding is available in account number 1023-068-2439-3197.

APPROVALS:

The Environmental Protection and Business Development Divisions concur with this recommendation.

REMARKS:

Four bids were received in response to this Invitation for Bids and were evaluated for responsiveness, responsibility, and price reasonableness. The bid from Schuller Contractors Incorporated was deemed non-responsive by the Procurement Division, based on the analysis provided by the Business Development Division, which identified that the M/WBE participation goal was not achieved, and sufficient good faith effort documentation was not provided. The bid submitted by Valencia Construction Group, Inc. was deemed non-responsible based on project elements that were not able to be verified. A timely protest was filed by Schuller Contractors Incorporated. A protest review was held by the Procurement Manager on December 1, 2021, and the decision was rendered to deny the protest. No timely appeals were received. References provided were satisfactory for this type of work and Carr & Collier, Inc., has been determined to be responsible. Therefore, award is recommended to Carr & Collier, Inc.

The Business Development Division evaluated all four bids submitted for this project. The Business Development Division completed an M/WBE Availability Analysis. The scope of services for this project had limited Minority/Women Business Enterprise availability. As a result, the M/WBE goal was reduce to 7%. At the time of bid opening, at least 69 M/WBE firms were certified to provide the scope of services at the subcontract level.

The apparent low bidder, submitted by Orange County MBE firm Valencia Construction Group, Inc., is bidding as a Prime contractor. Therefore, Valencia Construction Group, Inc., is required to self-perform no less than 51% of the contract per Sec. 17-321 per the M/WBE Ordinance. In the event this requirement is not achieved, other M/WBE's will have to be included to achieve the 7% M/WBE goal. Valencia Construction Group, Inc., reported self-performing 54.31% with 0.00% sub-contractor's participation on attachment C-2. Therefore, the M/WBE participation goal was met. The apparent second low bidder, submitted by Schuller Contractors Incorporated, reported 3.46% in M/WBE participation. They did not meet the 7% M/WBE participation goal and did not provide sufficient good faith effort documentation. Please note the following certified M/WBE participation:
