Request the Board to authorize negotiation and execution of the final contract by the Procurement Division, in the total estimated award amount of \$279,700 for a three-year term. Further request authorization for the Procurement Division to renew the contract for two additional one-year terms.

The consultant will assist in developing and soliciting a new solid waste/recycling collection agreement including conducting background research, updating and soliciting feedback from interested parties, developing the procurement documents and evaluation requirements, evaluating proposals, and potentially assisting with contract negotiations. As additional services, the County may engage the Consultant to perform on-going assistance with collection agreement implementation, updating County ordinances, and other collection and solid waste/recycling program policy related activities as directed by the County's project manager.

Two proposals were received in response to this Request for Proposals (RFP). The proposals were evaluated by the Procurement Committee in accordance with the criteria set forth in the RFP. Consensus scores from the Procurement Committee's evaluation for the selected firms are attached.
