## Project Summary

Avalon Road (C.R. 545) is planned to be widened from two lanes to four lanes between U.S. 192 and Hartzog Road, a distance of approximately 1.6 miles. The project includes a sidewalk on the east side of the roadway and a shared-use path on the west side. Additional improvements will include upgraded drainage systems, new traffic signalization, enhanced roadway lighting, intersection upgrades, and landscaping.

This roadway widening will increase capacity to accommodate future travel demands, reducing congestion and improving overall traffic flow. The addition of a sidewalk and a shared-use path will enhance safety and connectivity for pedestrians and bicyclists, creating a more accessible and multimodal corridor.
