Environmental Protection Commission Recommendation for Request for Waiver for Kenneth and Adrianne Fuhr Dock

Construction Permit BD-21-08-118

The applicants, Kenneth and Adrianne Fuhr, are requesting a dock construction permit with approval of a waiver to Orange County Code (Code), Chapter 15, Article IX, Section 15-342(b) (terminal platform size). The project site is located at 7651 Green Mountain Way, Winter Garden, FL 34787 (Parcel ID number 28-23-27-8318-11-180). The subject property is on Lake Hancock in District 1.

On August 23, 2021, the Environmental Protection Division (EPD) received an Application to Construct a Dock for the subject property. Included with the application was an Application for Waiver to Section 15-342(b) (terminal platform size) requesting to increase the terminal platform size from the maximum allowed by Code of 640 square feet to 816 square feet.

Waiver Request - Terminal Platform Size

Chapter 15, Article IX, Section 15-342(b) of the Code states, "the maximum square footage of the terminal platform shall not exceed the square footage of ten times the linear shoreline frontage for the first seventy-five (75) feet of shoreline and five times the linear shoreline frontage for each foot in excess of seventy-five (75) feet, not to exceed a maximum of 1,000 square feet." The applicants have a shoreline that measures approximately 64 linear feet at the Normal High Water Elevation, allowing for a maximum terminal platform size of 640 square feet. The applicants are requesting to construct a dock with a terminal platform size of 816 square feet (176 square feet larger than allowed).

Pursuant to Section 15-350(a)(2), "the applicant shall describe (1) how this waiver would not negatively impact the environment, and (2) the effect of the proposed waiver on abutting shoreline owners."

To address Section 15-350(a)(2)(1), the applicants' agent, Ms. Sheila Cichra, states, "The terminal platform will be constructed over open water, so there will not be any impact to

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wetland vegetation. The proposed terminal platform is only 176 square feet over the allowed limit and similar in size to the adjacent docks."

To address Section 15-350(a)(2)(2), the applicants' agent states, "The proposed structure will not adversely affect the adjacent property owner's view or navigability."

The applicants have agreed to make a mitigation payment of \$198 to the Conservation Trust Fund (CTF) to offset the additional shading impacts to Lake Hancock associated with the larger terminal platform size should the waiver request be approved.

Public Noticing

On September 10, 2021, Notices of Application for Waiver were sent to all shoreline property owners within a 300-foot radius of the property. Delivery could not be confirmed for any of the certified letters that were mailed. On October 6, 2021, EPD requested that the applicants' agent print the notices, post them on the front doors of the shoreline owners in the 300-foot radius, and provide EPD photos of the notices for verification. EPD received photo-documentation of the postings on October 27, 2021. No objections have been received.

Enforcement Action

On December 6, 2019, EPD received a complaint regarding an unauthorized dock being constructed on the subject lot by the previous owners. Accordingly, EPD initiated an enforcement case for the unauthorized dock (#19-560343) and a Notice of Violation dated December 16, 2019 was sent via certified mail to the previous owners. In order to resolve the enforcement actions, the dock was removed. In addition, a penalty of \$3,999 was assessed, which was paid by the previous owners in May 2021. The property is currently in compliance.

EPD Staff Evaluation

Staff has evaluated the waiver request for compliance with the criteria for approval. The recommendation of the Environmental Protection Officer (EPO) is to approve the request for waiver to Section 15-342(b) (terminal platform size) based on a finding that the applicants have demonstrated there will be no negative effects on the abutting shoreline owners pursuant to Section 15-350(a)(2)(2), as no objections have been received. Additionally, pursuant to Section 15-350(a)(2)(1), negative effects to the environment due to shading impacts from the excess terminal platform size will be offset through a mitigation payment of \$198 to the CTF.

Environmental Protection Commission Public Hearing

EPD presented the waiver request in a public hearing before the EPC at their December 9, 2021 meeting. Based upon evidence and testimony presented at the hearing, the EPC voted unanimously to accept the findings and recommendation of the EPO, and recommended approval of the request for waiver to Section 15-342(b) (terminal platform size) with a mitigation payment of \$198 to the CTF.

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ACTION REQUESTED:

Acceptance of the findings and recommendation of the Environmental Protection Commission and approval of the request for waiver to Section 15-342(b) to increase the maximum allowable terminal platform size from 640 to 816 square feet with a mitigation payment of \$198 to the Conservation Trust Fund within 60 days of the decision of the Board of County Commissioners for the Kenneth and Adrianne Fuhr Dock Construction Permit BD-21-08-118. District 1














FUHR ELEVATION 7651 GREEN MOUNTAIN WAY WINTER GARDEN, FL 34787
