Ordinance Title: **AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE XV, "MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL APPROVAL OF RESIDENTIAL REZONINGS AND COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AMENDMENTS," CHAPTER 30, OF THE ORANGE COUNTY CODE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

Commission Districts: All

BCC Public Hearings Required by: Section 125.66(2)(a), Florida Statutes

Advertising Requirements: At least 10 days before the BCC public hearing at 2:00 p.m. on September 1, publish an advertisement in a portion of *The Orlando Sentinel* other than the legal notices or classified advertisement portion describing the ordinance and giving the date, time, and place when the BCC public hearing will be held. The

advertisement must be no less than 2 columns wide by 10 inches long and the headline in the advertisement must be in a type no smaller than 18 point.

Special Instructions to the Clerk's Office:

Please schedule the public hearing for September 1, 2020, to begin at 2:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard.

Our office will send you a copy of the actual ordinance on or before the date the advertisement appears in *The Orlando Sentinel* for the September 1st public hearing.
