This work session will present information from Septic Tank Workgroup Subgroup B which is evaluating septic to sewer conversions for existing systems. The Subgroup is comprised of staff from multiple county departments.

Conventional septic tank systems provide safe, cost effective wastewater treatment when used in the appropriate location and density. However, there are scenarios in which connection to a centralized sewer system or upgraded septic tank systems may be more appropriate.

At this work session, staff will provide background information on the objectives of the Subgroup, summarize alternative technologies for converting from septic to sewer, present the current projects and studies related to septic tanks, and outline the proposed policy and funding options for future discussions with the Board.
