ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval to award Invitation for Bids Y22-761-RC, Sheriff's Aviation Upgrades (Fuel Tank, Skid and Slab), to the low responsive and responsible bidder, Café Construction & Development Inc. in the total contract award amount of \$113,360, inclusive of Alternate No. 1.

PROCUREMENT:

This project includes the removal, replacement and disposal of the existing fuel tank, skid and slab on grade. The Contractor shall also connect new equipment. Alternate No. 1 includes a new chain fence enclosure around the recently installed new emergency generator. The project is located in District 3.

FUNDING:

Funding is available in account number 1023-023-4432-3810.

APPROVALS:

The Capital Projects and Business Development Divisions concur with this recommendation.

REMARKS:

Three bids were received in response to the Invitation for Bids and were evaluated for responsiveness, responsibility, and price reasonableness.

Award Invitation for Bid Y22-761-RC, Sheriff's Aviation Upgrades (Fuel Tank, Skid and Slab)

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The bid submitted from Café Construction & Development Inc. is considered reasonable based on comparison to the engineer's estimate. References provided were satisfactory for this type of work and Café Construction & Development Inc. has been determined to be responsible. Therefore, award is recommended to Café Construction & Development Inc.


The Business Development Division evaluated three bids submitted for this project. The Business Development Division completed an M/WBE Availability Analysis. The scope of services for this project had Minority/Women Business Enterprise availability. As a result, the M/WBE goal will remain at 25%. At the time of bid opening, at least 63 M/WBE firms were certified to provide the scope of services at the subcontract level.

The apparent low bidder, submitted by Orange County MBE firm Café Construction & Development, Inc., is bidding as a Prime contractor. Therefore, Café Construction & Development, Inc. is required to self-perform no less than 51 % of the contract per Sec. 17-321 per the M/WBE Ordinance. In the event this requirement is not achieved, other M/WBE's will have to be included to achieve the 25% M/WBE goal. Café Construction & Development, Inc., reported self-performing 59.16% with 25.99% subcontractor's participation on attachment C-2. They met the 25% M/WBE participation goal. Please note the following certified M/WBE participation:

The apparent second low bidder, submitted by CORE Engineering & Construction, Inc., reported 31.35% in M/WBE participation. They met the 25% M/WBE participation goal. Please note the following certified M/WBE participation:
