SUBJECT: Approval of Contract Y23-2040, Suspension Prevention/Intervention
Program East

ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval of Contract Y23-2040, Suspension Prevention/Intervention Program East, with The IMPACT Outreach Ministry of Central Florida, Inc., in the total contract award amount of \$300,000 for a three-year term.

PURPOSE:

This contract will provide funds to assist students who are suspended from or in danger of being suspended from the targeted area public and private, elementary, middle, and high schools by providing a safe, nurturing environment where students will be supervised by a team of adults, receive access to their school assignments, intervention, gain life and social skills training, and be treated with respect and dignity. The performance period is January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2025.

FUNDING:

Funding is available in account number 0001-062-2556-8610.

APPROVALS:

The Citizens' Review Panel for Human Services (CRP) recommended The IMPACT Outreach Ministry of Central Florida, Inc. to receive CRP funding to provide Suspension Prevention/Intervention Program East. The Citizens' Commission for Children Division concurs with the funding recommendation.

REMARKS:

In accordance with the Code of Ordinances, Part 1, Chapter 17, Article III, Section 17-286 – Application and Exclusions, agreements between the Board and nonprofit organizations are excluded from competitive procurement requirements.

The IMPACT Outreach Ministry of Central Florida, Inc. will provide Suspension Prevention/Intervention Program to provide academic support, life and social skills training,

youth mentoring, and drug and violence prevention services to students in East Orange County, who have been or are suspended from school, at-risk of being suspended, have received multiple disciplinary referrals, and/or at-risk for these behaviors as well as those in an alternative school setting due to behavioral issues.
