ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval to award Invitation for Bids Y23-731-MB, Corrections Phoenix Smoke Control and Building Automation Systems Replacement, to the sole responsive and responsible bidder, Air Mechanical & Service Corp., in the total contract award amount of \$3,578,057.

PROCUREMENT:

Work under this contract will consist of replacing the smoke control and building automation systems. The work will include cleaning all ductwork and air handling equipment, as well as replacing the building automation system wiring, controllers, dampers, and actuators as necessary to control the building environment systems. The project is located in District 6.

FUNDING:

Funding is available in account number 1023-043-2049-3810.

APPROVALS:

The Capital Projects and Business Development Divisions concur with this recommendation.

REMARKS:

One bid was received in response to this Invitation for Bids and was evaluated for responsiveness, responsibility, and price reasonableness. A negotiation and scope review meeting was held on May 5, 2023. The bid exceeded the engineer's and project estimate. In accordance with the Procurement Ordinance, the Capital Projects Division entered into negotiations with the sole bidder and successfully negotiated a reduction of \$281,840. Staff determined that the bid from Air Mechanical & Service Corp., is considered reasonable for this type of work based on market factors. References provided by Air Mechanical & Service Corp. were verified and satisfactory for this type of work. Therefore, the award is recommended to Air Mechanical & Service Corp.

The Business Development Division evaluated one bid submitted for this project. The Business Development Division completed a M/WBE Availability Analysis. The scope of services for this project had limited M/WBE availability. As a result, the M/WBE goal was reduced from 25% to 17%. At the time of bid opening; at least 33 firms were certified to provide the scope of services at the subcontract level.

The apparent low bid, submitted by Air Mechanical & Service Corp., reported 18.41% in M/WBE participation and met the Orange County M/WBE participation goal per the Ordinance requirement. Please note the following certified M/WBE participation:
