Maintenance and Support

ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval of Purchase Order M113625, Asset Management Software Licensing, Maintenance, and Support, with iWorQ Systems Inc, in the amount of \$777,192.20.

PROCUREMENT:

This purchase order will renew software licensing, maintenance and support for an asset management software package with in-house pavement assessment that will integrate with Aurigo software that the Public Works Engineering Division will use for engineering projects. The performance period is February 8, 2024 through February 7, 2025.

FUNDING:

Funding is available in the account numbers 1002-072-2701-6440 and 1002-072-2701-3192.

APPROVALS:

The Roads and Drainage Division concurs with this recommendation.

REMARKS:

A sole source public posting was issued on December 1, 2022, to gauge and collect information from firms with capability and experience in providing an asset management software package with inhouse pavement assessment that will integrate with Aurigo software. The system provides both pavement and signal and sign assessment, as well as provide their enterprise cloud software package. iWorQ integrates with Aurigo software that Public Works Engineering Division utilizes, is an Esri Partner and integrates with the County's current GIS system. iWorQ will be used by Public Works Roads and Drainage, Stormwater, and Traffic Engineering Divisions for Asset Management and Pavement Management software. One vendor responded to the sole source posting. Following an

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analysis it was determined that their software application failed to provide necessary functionality for the division's operation needs.

The Roads and Drainage staff found the pricing to be fair and reasonable for the scope of work required and the features provided by the software application. While iWorQ's competitors charge a per license fee, iWorQ is one price for unlimited users, allowing multiple users to use the software which is a savings to the County.
