ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval of Amendment No. 3, Contract Y17-1068, Group Term Life, Accidental Death, Long and Short-Term Disability and Dismemberment, with The Standard Insurance Company, to extend the contract for one-year term.

PROCUREMENT:

This amendment extends the current contract for the period of January 1, 2023, through December 31, 2023, to allow sufficient time for the re-solicitation process to be completed.

FUNDING:

APPROVALS:

The Human Resources Division concurs with this request.

REMARKS:

On September 19, 2017, the Board authorized award of Y17-1068-LC for a three-year term with further authorization for the Procurement Division to renew the contract for two additional one-year terms. Request for Proposals Y22-1005-KK was issued to replace this contract but was cancelled due to all proposers being found non-responsive.

This contract provides Group Term Life, Long and Short-Term Disability, and Accidental Death and Dismemberment insurance for the employee benefits plan.
