ORANGE COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

regarding

UTILITIES BILLING ADJUSTMENTS FOR EXCESSIVE WATER CONSUMPTION; ADDING RECLAIMED WATER TO THE EXISTING UTILITIES BILLING ADJUSTMENT SCHEDULE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Orange County Board of County Commissioners (“BCC”) establishes and collects rates, fees, and charges for Orange County’s water, wastewater, and reclaimed water system pursuant to the County’s home rule powers granted by the Florida Constitution, the Orange County Charter, Chapter 125 of Florida Statutes, and any other applicable statutory authority; and

WHEREAS, the BCC recognizes that there are instances where customers have been charged for water, wastewater, and reclaimed water usage that may be considered beyond their control and where the amount charged could be considered excessively punitive; and

WHEREAS, on May 8, 2012, the BCC adopted Resolution No. 2012-M-11, which created criteria and an “Utilities Billing Adjustment Schedule” to allow for billing adjustments for the excessive use of water and wastewater; and

WHEREAS, the BCC now desires to add reclaimed water to the existing “Utilities Billing Adjustment Schedule”.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY:

Section 1. Amending the “Utilities Billing Adjustment Schedule”. The BCC hereby amends Exhibit “A” of Resolution No. 2012-M-11, to include reclaimed water in the “Utilities Billing Adjustment Schedule”, as shown in the attached Exhibit “A”, with additions shown by underlines and deletions by strike-throughs.

Section 2. Effective date. This Resolution shall take effect on October 1, 2025.
