


Collection Program

- Approximately 230,000 residential households in the Solid Waste Municipal Services Benefit Unit (MSBU)
- Unincorporated area divided into five collection zones
- One exclusive collection provider per zone
- Weekly garbage, recycling, yard waste, and large item collections

MSBU Background

- Hauler compensation initially set by bid and adjusted annually
- BCC approves hauler compensation by July 15
- BCC tentatively approves MSBU rate included in proposed property tax notice sent in August
- Final BCC adoption of MSBU rate at first Budget
 Public Hearing in September

MSBU Rate Components





MSBU Rate Components

- -Collection
 - Annual adjustment based on contract
- –Disposal
 - Annual adjustment based on waste generation by customers and tip fee
- Administration
 - Budget reflects overhead and personnel costs





MSBU Rate Components

- Recycling
 - Recycling Processing Agreement
 - Recycling Quality Improvement Program (RQIP)
- -Carts
 - Purchase for new residential units and replacement carts
 - Prepare for end-of-life cart replacement
- -Reserves/Rate Stabilization
 - Smooth future rate increases




- Recycling QualityImprovement Program
 - -230,000 homes tagged
 - -60% of carts out weekly
 - -84% of carts out monthly
 - -24% improvement w/RQIP
 - -10% of households not responsive








- Recycling QualityImprovement Program

 - -Working with UCF
 - -Understand demographics
 - -Survey households
 - -Consider program changes


