
- Existing yard trash processing facility that accepts yard trash for recycling and processing into firewood, fines for topsoil, mulch, and colored mulch
- The Board approved the original operational permit (SW-072228-YT-12/1210) in October 2012
- In accordance with Chapter 32, Article V, permits are valid for a maximum period of 5 years
- Located within City of Ocoee



- Applicant requests the following:
 - -Transfer of the permit from "Raynor Shine Recycling Solutions, LLC" to "Raynor Shine Services, LLC"
 - –Renewal of the permit with modifications:
 - Increase the maximum storage pile volume from 10,000 to 30,000 cubic yards during normal operations
 - Increase the maximum storage pile volume to 55,000 cubic yards and increase operating days and hours during a State of Emergency declared by the Governor






Site Plan
