PROJECT: Y25-714-RC, Utilities John Young Parkway 20-Inch High Density Polyethylene Replacement (Revised)

The Business Development Division evaluated 2 bids of the 5 bids submitted for this project. The Business Development Division completed an M/WBE Availability Analysis. The scope of services for this project had M/WBE availability. As a result, the M/WBE goal remained at 25%. At the time of bid opening, at least 52 firms were certified to provide the scope of services at the subcontract level.

The apparent low bid, submitted by R.P. Utility & Excavation Corp., reported 25.26% in M/WBE participation. The apparent low bid met the Orange County M/WBE participation goal **per the Ordinance requirement.** Please note the following certified M/WBE participation:

The second low bid, submitted by Metro Equipment Service, Inc., reported 25.19% in M/WBE participation. The second low bid met the Orange County M/WBE participation goal **per the Ordinance requirement.** Please note the following certified M/WBE participation:
