DIRECTOR AND DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT AND TO THE MANAGER OF THE TRAFFIC ENGINEERING DIVISION TO APPROVE CERTAIN TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES

WHEREAS, from time to time, pursuant to its legal authority under Section 316.006(3), Florida Statutes, the Board of County Commissioners approves the installation of traffic control devices; and

WHEREAS, in order to expedite addressing transportation and operational needs of motorists, pedestrians, bicyclists, and others, the Board of County Commissioners desires to delegate the authority to approve certain traffic control devices to the Director and Deputy Director of the Public Works Department and to the Manager of the Traffic Engineering Division.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY:

- **Section 1.** Recitals. The foregoing recitals are true and correct, and are incorporated herein by reference.
- Section 2. Delegation of Authority. The Board of County Commissioners hereby delegates to the Director and Deputy Director of the Public Works Department


and to the Manager of the Traffic Engineering Division the authority to approve the installation of the following traffic control devices:

- A. No parking signs, as requested by the Fire Marshal based on roadway width limitations impeding the access of emergency vehicles to the subdivision:
- B. All traffic control signs, including speed limit signs, stop signs, yield signs, no parking signs, pedestrian crossing signs, street name signs, and destination signs, in residential and commercial subdivisions approved after the effective date of this Resolution;
- C. Speed humps and speed tables, provided at least sixty-six percent (66%) of the homeowners within the subdivision or along the roadway where the speed humps or speed tables will be installed favor the installation of the speed humps or speed tables, a traffic study supports installation of the speed humps or speed tables, and at least fifty percent (50%) of the costs of the speed humps or speed tables are paid by the benefitted community, such as the homeowners association, or by the District Commissioner's Public Works Department funds; and
- D. Conversion of yield signs to stop signs because their life cycle has expired or they do not comply with minimum retro-reflectivity industry standards.
