SUBJ: **Establishment of a Multi-Way Stop Condition at Intersection of Caneel Bay Boulevard and Stonewyck Street**

Traffic Engineering staff recommends that the existing one-way stop control of Caneel Bay Boulevard and Stonewyck Street be converted to a multi-way stop control at the intersection.

The multi-way stop control was a condition of approval for a development plan, case number DP-20-12-357, at Caneel Bay Boulevard and Stonewyck Street. The multi-way stop will assist with safety of student pedestrians and relieve the traffic for the new elementary school (Site 30) opening at Stonewyck Street and Woodmoor Street.

Staff recommends that the Board approve the establishment of a multi-way stop condition at Caneel Bay Boulevard and Stonewyck Street.

Action Requested: Approval of a multi-way stop installation at Caneel Bay Boulevard and Stonewyck Street. District 4.

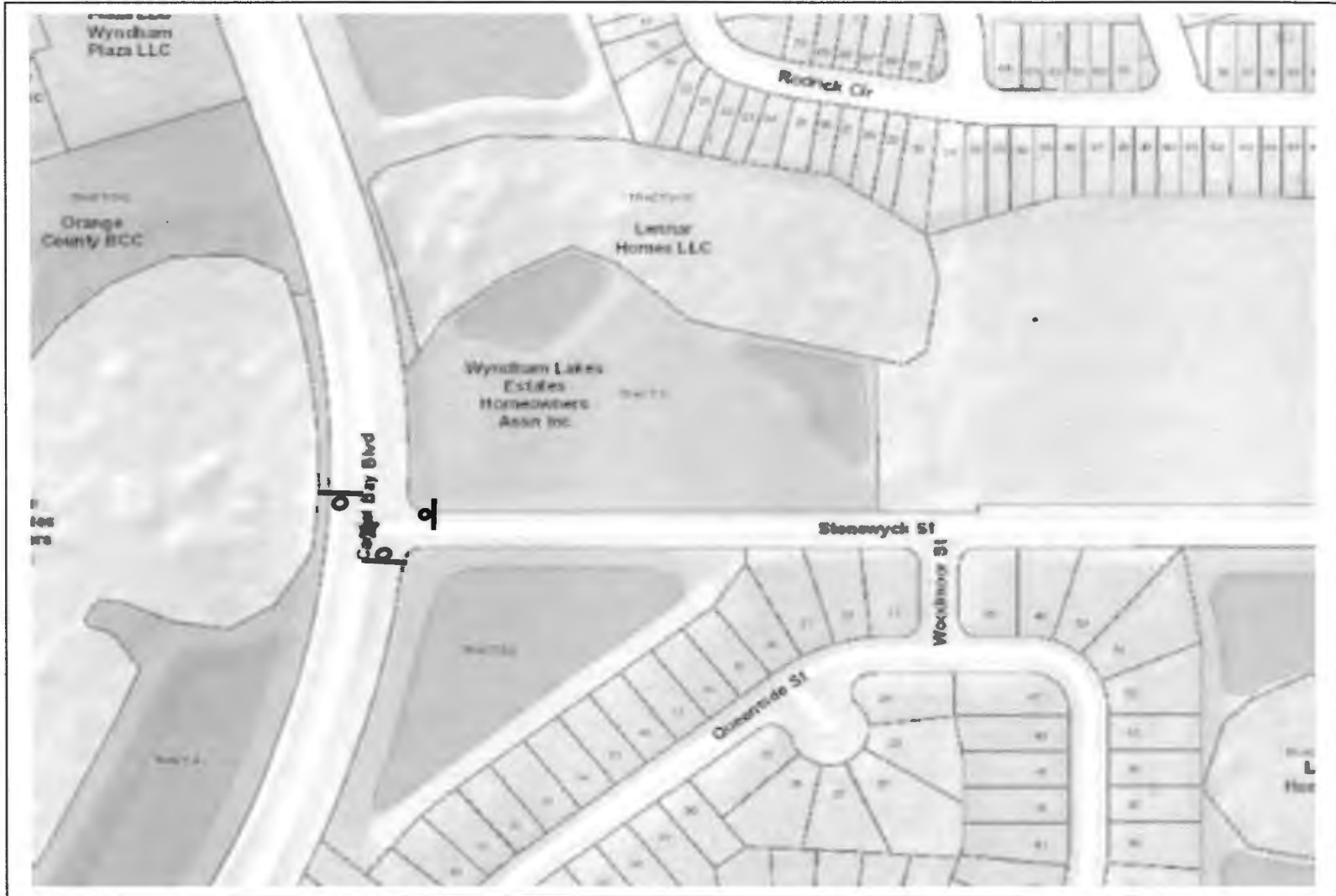
Caneel Bay Boulevard and Stonewyck Street Consent Agenda District Map
