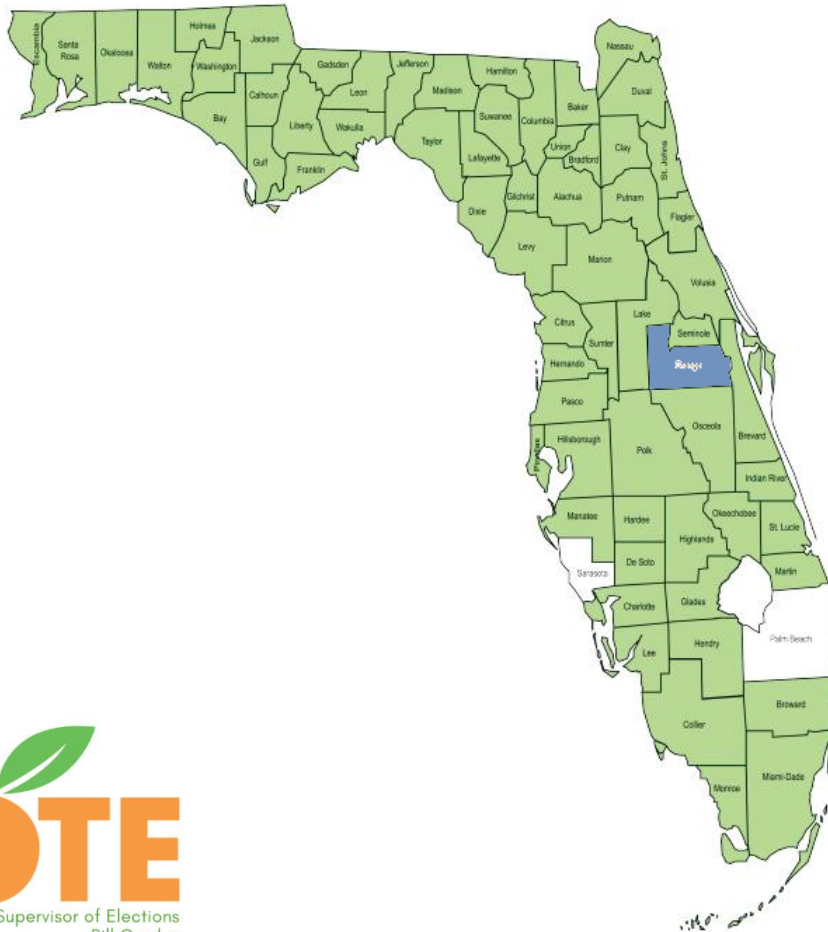

 - Respond to information requests
 - Stay up-to-date with state requirements
 - Tightly integrated with information services on the web
- ...and more

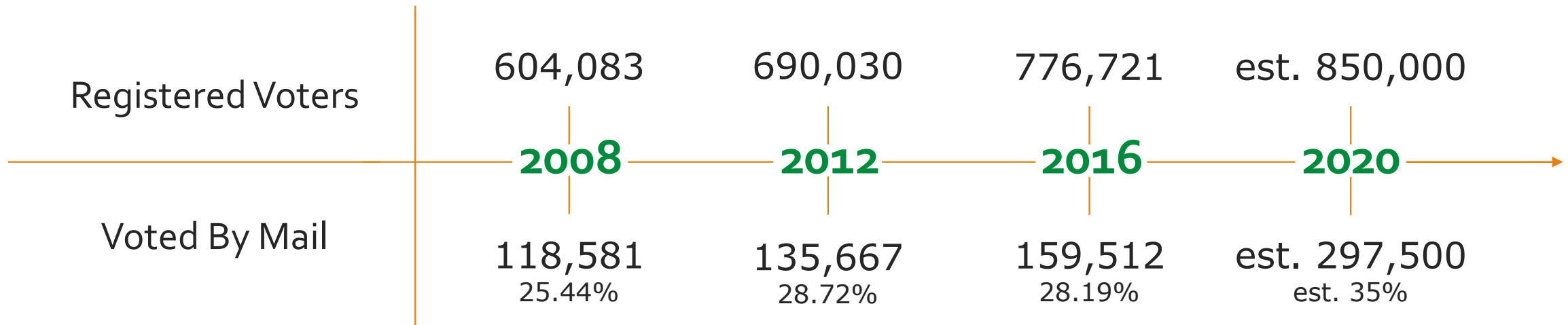


Timeline for Conversion

- March 26th, 2019: Board of County Commission approval / contract executed
 - Conversion expected to take 9 months
- November 5th, 2019: City of Orlando – last on current system
- December 16th, 2019: Voter Focus goes live
- March 17th, 2020: Florida's Presidential Preference Primary and Municipal Elections

Conversion Cost: \$880,000

Presidential Election Years



Additional Voting Equipment Needed

- Increase in voting by mail
- Sorting early voting ballots for potential recounts/audits
- Dreaded recounts



Additional units for:

- Expanded early voting sites
- Hands-on poll worker training
- Backups for Election Day

Cost: \$723,775

DS200 Modems

- Verizon retiring 3G network/modems
- Upgrading current DS200 voting machines
