Subsection (c) of Section 15-30 ("Same – Section 1. 46 Organization") pertaining to the composition and representative membership of the Environmental Protection Commission is amended to read as follows, with additions being shown by underlines 48 and deletions being shown by strike-throughs: Section 15-30. Same – Organization. 50 The Orange County Environmental Protection (a) Commission established pursuant to this act [article] shall consist of 52 seven (7) members appointed by the board of county commissioners 54 and shall comply with chapter 2, article VI, creation, operation, review of advisory boards, of this Code. 56 (b) Appointments shall be made by the board of county 58 commissioners. 60 The composition and representative membership of the commission shall be as follows: 62 A representative who is a professional engineer (1) 64 registered licensed in the state, pursuant to the requirements of Chapter 471, Florida Statutes, as amended from time to time, with experience in the field 66 of eivil engineering or environment engineering that is 68 relevant to the duties and responsibilities of the

commission;

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- (2) A representative of the agricultural interests industry actively engaged in agricultural operations, such as, but not limited to, bona fide farming, pasture, grove, or forestry operations, including horticulture, floriculture, viticulture, dairy, livestock, poultry, bee, and aquaculture;
