Subject: Award of Invitation for Bids Y22-799-SH, Buck Road B ridge Replacement Over the Little Econlockhatchee River Project

### ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval to award Invitation for Bids Y22-799-SH, Buck Road Bridge Replacement Over the Little Econlockhatchee River Project, to the low responsive and responsible bidder, Atlantic Civil Constructors Corporation, in the total contract award amount of \$9,533,803.35.

In the event the bidder recommended above fails to achieve timely compliance with pre-award deliverables, as defined in the Invitation for Bids, including, but not limited to, M/WBE participation sub-contract agreements, State Division of Corporations registration, E-verify, insurance and bonds, further request authorization for the Procurement Division to award to the next low responsive and responsible bidder as listed in the bid tabulation herein, to the extent practicable and advantageous to the County.

### PROCUREMENT:

Work under this contract consists of the Buck Road bridge replacement over the Little Econlockhatchee River including the roadway approaches from west of Riverdale Road to Rouse Road and roadway improvements to Riverdale Road. The project includes existing bridge removal, new bridge construction, sheet pile walls, earthwork, milling and resurfacing, curb and gutter, concrete sidewalk, drainage pipes and structures, erosion control, sodding, pavement markings, signs, traffic signalization, maintenance of traffic, and utility coordination. The project length is approximately 1,025 feet. The project is located in District 5.

### FUNDING:

Funding is available in account number 7539-072-2852-6311. This project is federally funded through the Florida Department of Transportation Local Agency Program.

### APPROVALS:

The Public Works Engineering Division and Business Development Division concur with this recommendation.

REMARKS:

Five bids were received in response to this Invitation for Bids and evaluated for responsiveness, responsibility, and price reasonableness. The bid submitted by Atlantic Civil Constructors Corporation is considered reasonable based on comparison to the engineer's estimate. References provided were satisfactory for this type of work and Atlantic Civil Constructors Corporation has been determined to be responsible. Therefore, award is recommended to Atlantic Civil Constructors Corporation.

Orange County is receiving U. S. Department of Transportation funding from the Florida Department of Transportation (“FDOT”) for the services solicited in the Invitation for Bids. Pursuant to the funding requirement of the FDOT’s grant, disadvantage business enterprise (“DBE”) utilization shall be in compliant with applicable laws and regulations. FDOT has established a DBE program in accordance with such federal laws and regulations.

Orange County shall participate in FDOT’s DBE program for this solicitation, and the Orange County’s Minority/Women Business Enterprise (M/WBE) participation goals for M/WBE firms are not applicable for this proposal. The DBE goal set for this project is 10.65%.
