City of Ocoee	Roper Parkway and Capitol Court Drainage Improvement Project	The proposed Project consists of drainage improvements to improve the flood resiliency of the communities located in the western portion of the Lake Lotta Basin. The upgraded culverts will provide a larger drainageway for stormwaters to be safely conveyed through the basin. This will mitigate the flood risk by removing two bottle necks in the storm sewer system that causes upstream staging of stormwaters.	\$486,627
City of Orlando	Haralson Estates Stormwater and Flood Mitigation Project	The proposed Project include general construction activities associated with replacing the existing swale drainage system with a modern closed drainage system, installation of underground stormwater pipes, and construction of sidewalks and resurfacing of roadway. These improvements will control the flow of excess rainwater, significantly improve water conveyance and reduce standing water on the roadways and private property while the construction of sidewalks and resurfacing of roadways will enhance pedestrian and vehicular safety and accessibility. Additionally, costs include acquisition for retention ponds and pump overflow to Lake Mann.	\$8,701,411.36

City of Orlando	Richmond Heights Flood Mitigation	The proposed Project covers design, general conditions and general construction activities associated with increasing the capacity of the existing underperforming stormwater system to mitigate street flooding, protect homes and ensure evacuation and safety routes are passable. The project will provide reprieve from flooding for 4,000 residents, relieving flooding on 12 roadways and prevent incursion of floodwater into homes to preserve affordable housing. Project includes repair or replacement of curb inlets, curb & gutter, drainage pipes, pipe culverts, manholes and baffle boxes.	\$12,498,549
