On September 1, 2020 and September 22, 2020 the Board accepted four Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grants from the U. S. Department of Justice, through the Florida Department of Law Enforcement, awarded to the Orange County Sheriff's Office (OCSO) for a total of \$162,576. Each of the four awards will be utilized to support approved law enforcement initiatives during the grant period from October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2021.

The OCSO will utilize \$38,000 to purchase eight additional road intersection cameras to be placed in key areas of Orange County to enhance and promote case resolution, security, law enforcement omnipresence, and a reduction in the fear of crime. They will also purchase four Community Observation License Plate Reader Compatible cameras and associated cable, fiber, or cellular connections for \$24,000. In addition, OCSO will purchase an Aviation Navigation and Display System totaling \$54,461. The OCSO will outfit the Aviation Section's assets with a new aircraft radio, navigation system, and enhanced flight display increasing mission readiness. Lastly, with the remaining \$46,115, the OCSO will purchase 12 Night Vision Monoculars and 12 helmet mounts for the SWAT Team.

On October 27, 2020, the Board approved a resolution authorizing the issuance of the Water and Wastewater Utility Revenue Bonds, Series 2020. Pursuant to the resolution, the bonds were sold through a competitive bid process and will be closed on December 7, 2020. The proceeds of the Series 2020 Bonds will be used to fund Water and Wastewater System expansion and rehabilitation projects in the current capital improvement plan.

In accordance with Section 129.06(2)(d), Florida Statutes, the FY 2020-21 budget requires an amendment to recognize the receipt of bond proceeds and their intended use according to bond covenants.

On October 1, 2020, the Board approved the first amendment to the agreement for the Coronavirus Relief Fund – State Housing Initiatives Partnership, increasing the award amount to \$9,281,435. This funding from the U.S. Department of Treasury, through the Florida Housing Finance Corporation was awarded to the Housing and Community Development Division, to assist Orange County residents in need of assistance with rental payments in response to the COVID-19 public health emergency. This amendment represents an increase of \$3,550,500 and the agreement period is from August 14, 2020 through March 31, 2021.
